### **Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award**

During 3<sup>rd</sup> Form your daughter has the opportunity to achieve the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award. This is the world's leading youth achievement award which is valued by employers and universities, it is also a fantastic chance for your daughter to push personal boundaries, gain new skills and enhance their CV's.

In order to complete the Bronze Award, students must spend three months volunteering, developing a skill and taking part in a physical activity once a week for one hour. They then must choose one of these areas to continue for a further three months.

Your daughter will also be required to complete the necessary training, a practice, and an assessment expedition which lasts two days (one night).

The expeditions are being run by Mountainwise, an experienced provider of DofE trips to many other schools in our area. Mountainwise staff will attend all expeditions to a ratio of one member of staff to seven pupils.

The cost of enrolment to the Bronze Award is £25 and the cost of the expedition run by Mountainwise is £300 which covers all training, both expedition weekends and all necessary camping equipment (excluding walking boots). Therefore the total cost of completing the Bronze Award is £325. Please be aware that on completing this form your deposit is non-refundable and that you are committed to paying the full balance.

There will be four training sessions which will run after school and will last 1.5 hours on the following dates: 21/02/17, 28/02/17, 02/03/17, and 07/03/17

Practice Expedition: 6<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> May 2017

Assessment Expedition: 10-11<sup>th</sup> June 2017

This is a fantastic award and one that many pupils have enjoyed and gained many benefits from. I look forward welcoming another strong team to the Bronze Award this year and invite them to attend an enrolment session on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> November 3:30-4:30pm at St Martha's.
